WHAT IS THE AT HOP CARD?

- A reusable prepay smart card for travel on buses, trains and ferries around Auckland.
- It gives you savings on fares you get at least 20% discount off adult single trip cash fares*. **Great even if you are a part time student and not eligible for a tertiary concession**.
- Lets you load a secondary or tertiary student concession for discounted fares.

HOW DO I USE THE AT HOP CARD?

Use your AT HOP card to tag on before you board your bus, train or ferry, then tag off when you finish your journey.

Always remember to tag on and off or you may be charged a penalty fare of up to \$20 depending on the service used and the distance travelled.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A STUDENT CONCESSION?

Secondary Students:

If you are 16-19 years of age and travel to school using public transport you are entitled to a secondary student concession on your AT HOP card. If you currently travel with a secondary student concession, it's due to expire on 31 March 2015. After this date if you haven't renewed the concession on your card, you will be charged adult fares.

Tertiary Students:

If you are a full time tertiary student, you are entitled to a tertiary concession on your AT HOP card. If you currently travel with a tertiary concession, it's due to expire on 31 March 2015. After this date if you haven't renewed the concession on your card, you will be charged adult fares.

- 4. Open the email that has been sent to you and click on the activation link.
- 5. Create your password.

- 6. Log in and confirm or update your details if they have changed since you created your account, click 'submit'.

SUBMIT YOUR CONCESSION APPLICATION ONLINE.

- Login to your MyAT account and select 'Apply for a Concession' from the menu.
- Confirm your details are correct.
- Select the card you wish to apply the concession to and fill out the relevant eligibility details.
- · Click 'submit'.



LOAD A CONCESSION ONTO YOUR AT HOP CARD.

Visit your nearest AT Customer Service Centre to load a concession on your card. Locations are listed overleaf.

Remember to take your AT HOP card and Student ID card along.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All current Tertiary & Secondary concessions on AT HOP cards expire on 31 March 2015.

If you are returning as a student you must renew your concession before this date or else you will be charged adult fares when you travel.

NOTE: This process does not apply to childern aged 5 to 15 years inclusive (until 16th birthday). A child concession can be applied online at AT.govt.nz/athop without the need to visit an AT Customer Service Centre.
